



Current HPV vaccination recommendations, United States

- Routine vaccination
 - Age 11 or 12 years
 - Can be started at age 9 years
- Catch-up vaccination
 - Through age 26 years
- Shared clinical decision-making
 - Age 27–45 years

Number of doses

2 doses (0, 6-12 months) if starting series before 15th birthday

3 doses (0,1-2, 6 months) if starting series on or after 15th birthday or if immunocompromising condition

- Number of doses in the recommended HPV vaccination series.
- Wording of the age for routine vaccination
- Guidance regarding persons in the "shared clinical decision-making" age range (27–45 years)

Number of doses in the recommended HPV vaccination series

- Accumulating evidence on efficacy of HPV vaccination with fewer doses
- In 2022, the World Health Organization recommended a two-dose schedule for persons aged 9 years or older and, as an off-label option, a single-dose schedule can be used for those aged 9–20 years

- Wording of the age for routine HPV vaccination
 - Some stakeholders interested in starting vaccination at age 9 years
 - Current ACIP recommendations are consistent with vaccination at age 9 years
 - Modification of wording could allow more flexibility

- Guidance regarding persons in the "shared clinical decision-making" age range (27–45 years)
 - Shared clinical decision-making recommendation made in 2019
 - Interest in providing more guidance for subgroups in this age range

- July 2024 first meeting of Work Group
- October 2024 presentation of general issues to full ACIP
 - Number of doses in the HPV vaccination schedule
 - Routine age recommendation wording
