Lap swimming

50-ft. pool 10 laps = .1 mile 100-ft. pool 5 laps = .1 mile 50-meter pool 3 laps = .1 mile

Running/jogging/walking

1/2 mile = .5 mile 1/4 mile = .3 mile 1/8 mile = .1 mile 1 block = .1 mile
