**The FY 2026 President's Budget supports CDC in meeting its core mission to prevent, detect, and respond to infectious disease and emerging health threats.**





Advancing public health preparedness to protect communities from health threats by incorporating elements of the Administration for Strategic Preparedness and Response (ASPR) to bolster response capacity.




Building public health infrastructure and defending Americans from hazardous exposures and global health threats by strengthening global and domestic threat prediction and response.
