



## Vaccinations among Health Care Personnel



The Map tab shows influenza vaccination coverage estimates across multiple geographies. Select one or more Geographies, one Personnel Type and one Season to view coverage estimates.

- Data represent influenza vaccination performance measurement for hospital-based health care personnel from the National Healthcare Safety Network.
- Pooled proportions for each state are calculated as the number of health care personnel (HCP) vaccinated at their facility plus the number who provided documentation of vaccination elsewhere, divided by the total number of HCP in that group reported as working at the facilities from October 1 through March 31, and multiplied by 100. Personnel are reported by each facility in which they work; therefore, individuals may be counted more than once.
- All Healthcare Personnel represents the pooled proportion vaccinated among employees, licensed independent practitioners, and adult students/trainees and volunteers combined.
