



How to Make Maps by Census Tract for Prevalence, Demographic, Social, and Risk Factor Data

Step 1: Open the Interactive Atlas of Heart Disease and Stroke at <https://nccd.cdc.gov/DHDSPAtlas/Default.aspx>




Step 2: Click on Select Map Area (located in the upper left corner), then choose your state.




Step 3: Click on the check box for Show Census Tracts.

Note* Maps by census tract can be created for **Prevalence, Demographic, Social Environment, and Risk Factor Data.**

For this example, we will be mapping **Social Environmental** data.



Step 3: Click on the **Social, Economic, Environmental Data** tab on the left navigation bar, then select **Social Environment**.



Step 4: Select **Poverty (%)** from the drop-down menu underneath **Social Environment** and the map of Poverty will appear!
