



How to Save a Map

Step 1: Open the Interactive Atlas of Heart Disease and Stroke at <https://nccd.cdc.gov/DHDSPAtlas/Default.aspx>


Step 2: Follow the instructions for “How to Make a Map” (see the top of this document for examples of maps that can be created). For this example, we map the prevalence of Blood Pressure Medication Nonadherence).




Step 3: Click on the **PDF/IMG** button on the tool bar on top.





Step 4: A PDF/IMG box will appear. Select **Landscape (48 States)** from the **Layout Type** drop-down menu.







Step 5: From the **Output Type** drop down menu select **PDF** (or any other format that you would like).

Click **Generate Preview** and the preview of the pdf will appear!




Step 6: Click **Print** and your pdf should emerge on another tab of your browser.






Step 7: Right click on the image and select **Save image as...**



Step 8: Rename your map and save it to your folder by clicking **Save**.



Step 9: Your image file should appear on the bottom of the screen. Click on the file and your image should appear!
