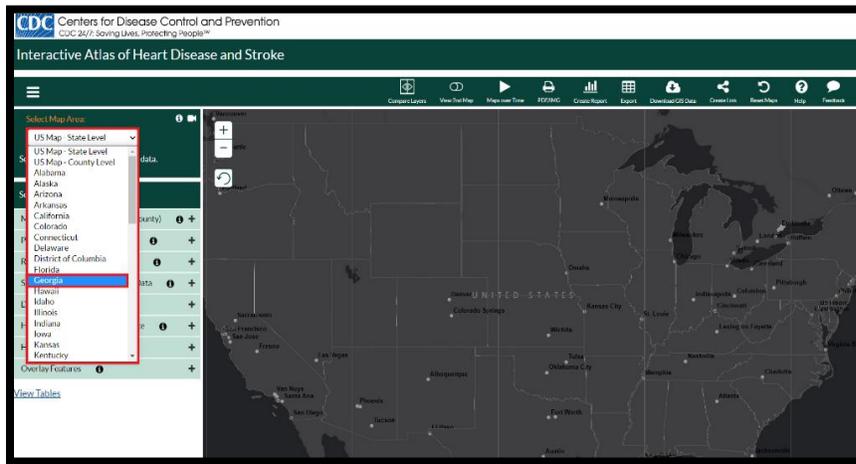


How to Make a Map of Social, Economic, or Environmental Data in Your State

Step 1: Open the Interactive Atlas of Heart Disease and Stroke at <https://nccd.cdc.gov/DHDSAtlas/Default.aspx>

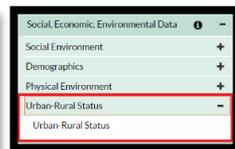
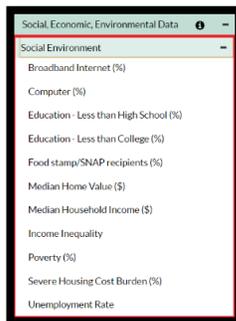


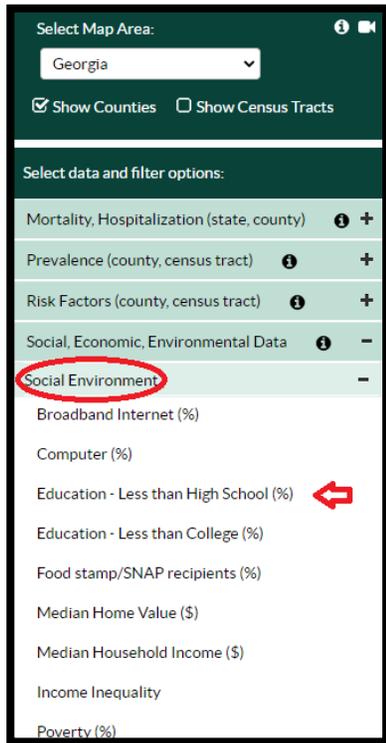
Step 2: Click on Select Map Area (located in the upper left corner), then choose your state.



Step 3: Click on the Social, Economic, Environmental Data tab on the left navigation bar, then select Social Environment.

Note* Social, Economic, Environmental Data is distinguished into three tabs Social Environment, Physical Environmental, and Urban-Rural Status. We will just focus on Social Environment in this example.





Step 4: Select **Education – Less than High School (%)** from the drop-down menu underneath **Social Environment** and the map of Education will appear!

Note* You will also see options for other Social Environment options you may want to map in the future.
