has been identified in this area!

- La Crosse virus is spread to people by the bite of an infected mosquito and can cause a rare but serious disease.
- Severe disease most often occurs in **children under 16 years old** and may include encephalitis (brain inflammation).

KEY SYMPTOMS

of La Crosse virus disease include:

Headache



ZZZ..

Fatigue

Fever



Vomiting

Nausea



Seizures

If your child or someone you know is experiencing the above symptoms, especially in the summer or fall when mosquitoes are active, **tell your healthcare provider immediately.**



You can help prevent the spread of La Crosse virus by:



Removing standing water, trash, and debris near your home



Using EPA-registered mosquito repellent especially when in wooded areas
