

Years of Healthy Life, 1990 and 1996 [Objective 8.1]


High school completion among persons 18-24 years, 1992 and 1997 [Objective 8.2]



Preschool child development programs, 1990-1997 [Objective 8.3]






Family discussion of health issues among children 10 years and older, 1994 [Objective 8.9]


College students 18-24 years who receive information on selected health topics, 1995














