Description of the Detailed Multiple Cause of Death (MCOD) Research Files

Detailed MCOD files are micro-data files. Publicly-available files are available for download, along with data documentation/users' guides, from: https://www.cdc.gov/nchs/data_access/vitalstatsonline.htm. Other than the publicuse files, there are two types of MCOD files that are available to researchers via the NCHS Data Request application form: the "All Counties" (A.K.A. "Part 2") file, and the "Limited Geography" file. Unlike the publicly-available files, the restricted research files contain geographical variables about the decedent.
