This document contains reference guides to aid users in reviewing their vaccination data reported to NHSN in response to the Quarterly Data Quality (DQ) reports.




Accessing the Quarterly Data Quality Reports

Healthcare facilities that report COVID-19 vaccination data in the Long-Term Care Facility Care Facility (LTCF) Component and the Healthcare Personnel Safety (HPS) Component can access their Quarterly Data Quality reports in the **Alerts** section of the NHSN homepage. **Please note**: For illustrative purposes we are using the LTCF Component for this example; however, accessing the Quarterly Data Quality reports will be the same for the HPS Component.

The name of the alert that contains the Quarterly Data Quality report is "View My COVID-19 Vaccination Summary DQ", as highlighted in the screenshot below:




The date that appears on the "View My COVID-19 Vaccination Summary DQ" alert will correspond to the date of upload of the most recent Quarterly Data Quality report. Please click on the date that is displayed to view the most recent Quarterly Data Quality report:



A table will be included in the Quarterly Data Quality report that contains all the data quality checks a facility has received for data submitted during the reporting quarter of interest. Once the data specified in the data quality checks have been reviewed and addressed as needed, you can disregard the Quarterly Data Quality report. The alert will continue to display on the NHSN homepage, as it contains a collection of all Quarterly Data Quality reports a facility has



received. To view historic Quarterly Data Quality reports, click on the drop-down box as indicated in the screenshot below:



Healthcare facilities that report patient COVID-19 vaccination data to NHSN through the Dialysis Component will receive an e-mail from NHSN with their Quarterly Data Quality report attached that can be accessed and downloaded.

For any questions concerning the Quarterly Data Quality reports, please use NHSN-ServiceNow to submit questions to the NHSN Help Desk. The new portal should be used in place of nhsn@cdc.gov, nhsntrain@cdc.gov, and nhsndua@cdc.gov. Users will be authenticated using CDC's Secure Access Management Services (SAMS), the same way you access NHSN. If you do not have a SAMS login, or are unable to access ServiceNow, you can still e-mail the NHSN Help Desk at: nhsn@cdc.gov.


1. Identifying if COVID-19 Vaccination Data were Reported:

Purpose


NHSN allows for and encourages weekly submission of COVID-19 vaccination data via the Weekly COVID-19 Vaccination Module. The NHSN team sends data quality checks to facilities that have not reported any data for any surveillance week during a reporting month. The information below will help facilities identify if data were reported for specific reporting week(s). After reviewing your data using one of the two options outlined below, be sure to update and save the data in the NHSN application as needed. This may include entering data for prior reporting weeks.

Option 1. Identifying missing data through review of data collection form

First, click on the Vaccination Summary tab on the left-hand navigation panel on the NHSN home screen. Second, select COVID-19 Weekly Vaccination Summary.



Next, use the arrow buttons to locate a week to review. Lastly, click on a week to review the data collection form. Please note that completed records are indicated in green. Incomplete records are indicated in light yellow.



Please note: the week-end date determines the month for which a week is included. For example, reporting data for the week of January 29, 2024 through February 4, 2024 is considered as submitting data for a week in February 2024, not January 2024. This is because the week-end date (February 4) is in February.



Option 2. Identifying Missing Data through Line List Reports

Line List reports describe in detail the data that have been reported in NHSN. NHSN has two options for Healthcare Personnel (HCP) COVID-19 Vaccination line list reports.


- All COVID-19 Vaccination Cumulative Summary Data
 This report includes summary-level information not dependent on vaccine manufacturer.
- All COVID-19 Vaccination Cumulative Detail Data
 This report includes manufacturer-dependent vaccine and dose specific counts. Vaccine names ending in the number "1" (e.g., MODERNA1) represent counts for the first dose of a 2-dose vaccination series.

For this example, we will modify the "Line Listing – All COVID-19 Vaccination Cumulative Summary Data" to confirm if data were submitted for any surveillance week during February 2024.


Modify and Run a Line List Report

Once you have generated your data set, you are ready to produce a line list.

- 1. On the "Analysis Reports" screen, click on the "COVID-19 Module" folder.
- 2. Select the "COVID-19 Vaccination Facility" Subfolder.
- 3. Click on "Line Listing All COVID-19 Vaccination Cumulative Summary Data - Facility" and select "Modify Report"



4. Click on the "Time Period" tab. Then, select the "survWeekStart" or "Week of data collection, start date" variable from the **Date Variable** drop-down box options. Next, enter a survey start week that includes February 4, 2024, as that is the date of the first Sunday in February 2024. The end period should include the start date of a survey week that includes February 25, 2024, as that is the date of the last Sunday in February 2024.



5. Click on the "Run" button. If data are not present during the specified time period, the "No Records Met Your Criteria" message will appear in the report output screen. If no data are present, please review your records and ensure data are reported as intended.

2. Reporting Up To Date COVID-19 Vaccination Status

Purpose

The NHSN Weekly COVID-19 Vaccination Modules allow facilities to enter weekly COVID-19 vaccination data for healthcare personnel (HCP), residents and/or patients. There are data quality flags built into the reporting forms that help identify possible irregularities in data. This quick reference guide will help facilities with the data quality flag associated with Question 2.

Overview of Question 2

Question 2 collects data about individuals who are *up to date* with COVID-19 vaccination. **Please note**: the definition of up to date for NHSN surveillance may change over time. Therefore, the vaccination data reported in Question 2 should correspond to the up to date definition applicable to the reporting week of interest. For example, if entering up to date vaccination data for the week of January 15 – 21, 2024, please use the up to date definition corresponding to Quarter 1 2024 (January 1, 2024 – March 31, 2024). To view the current up to date surveillance definition as well as previous definitions, please see: <u>CDC NHSN COVID-19 Vaccination Modules: Understanding Key Terms and Up To Date</u> Vaccination.



Question 3.1 collects data on individuals reporting medical contraindications related to the COVID-19 vaccination.



We suggest checking the reported number of individuals (Question 1) and the reported number of individuals with a medical contraindication (Question 3.1). Please note that the value in Question 3.1 may already be correct as initially reported.

There are data quality checks built into the reporting forms that help identify possible irregularities in data. Additionally, the NHSN team sends data quality checks to facilities with higher-than-expected values for certain data fields. This quick reference guide will help facilities review data to ensure accurate and complete reporting for Question 3.2.

Overview of Question 3.2

Question 3.2 collects data on individuals who have declined COVID-19 vaccination.

Please note: For illustrative purposes, we are using the LTCF Healthcare Personnel form for this example; however, this question is asked across all weekly COVID-19 Vaccination Modules.



We suggest checking the reported number of individuals (Question 1) and the reported number of individuals who declined vaccination (Question 3.2). Please note that the value in Question 3.2 may already be correct as initially reported.



Resolving Data Quality Concern for Question 3.2

Review data reported for Question 1 and Question 3.2 on the Form for the week(s) in question. If you find data entered in error, please correct, and resubmit these data.

Note: Individuals reporting philosophical, religious, or other reasons for declining COVID-19 vaccine not listed in the <u>Interim Clinical Considerations for Use of COVID-19 Vaccines Currently Approved or Authorized in the United States</u> should be counted in Question 3.2 for the purpose of NHSN COVID-19 vaccination surveillance. The number of individuals who declined COVID-19 vaccination should not include those reporting medical contraindications to the COVID-19 vaccine (medical contraindications are reported in Question 3.1).




If your facility receives a data quality check indicating that a high percentage of individuals were reported with an unknown/other COVID-19 vaccination status for a surveillance week, we ask that you confirm that the number and percentage of individuals who have an unknown COVID-19 vaccination status is correct. We suggest checking the reported number of individuals (Question 1) and the reported number of individuals with unknown/other vaccination status (Question 3.3). Please note that the value in Question 3.3 may already be correct as initially reported.



Resolving Data Concern for Question 3.3

Review data reported for Question 1 and Question 3.3 on the Form for the week(s) in question. If you find data entered in error, please correct and resubmit these data.

Note: As of January 1, 2024, individuals that are **not** up to date with COVID-19 vaccination (Question #2), do **not** have a medical contraindication to the latest COVID-19 vaccine needed to be considered up to date (Question #3.1), and have **not** declined the latest COVID-19 vaccine needed to be considered up to date (Question #3.2), should be reported in the **Unknown/Other COVID-19 vaccination status category (Question #3.3).**



6. Reporting Changes in COVID-19 Vaccination Data:

Purpose

The NHSN Weekly COVID-19 Vaccination Modules allow facilities to enter weekly COVID-19 vaccination data for healthcare personnel (HCP), residents and/or patients. There are data quality flags built into the reporting forms that help identify possible irregularities in data. This quick reference guide will help facilities with the data quality flag associated with increases or decreases in up to date vaccination percentages (Question #2) or in the total numbers of individuals reported (Question #1).

Overview of Question 1 and Question 2

As a reminder, weekly COVID-19 vaccination data are reported cumulatively. As a result, large increases or decreases in up to date vaccination percentages may represent a data quality error when comparing the week of interest to a prior week. To report cumulative data, facilities should report the total number of individuals at the facility for that week in Question #1. Of these individuals, report the number who are up to date with COVID-19 vaccination in Question #2.

NHSN's surveillance definition of up to date for COVID-19 vaccination data may change over time. Therefore, the vaccination data reported in Question #2 should correspond to the up to date definition applicable to the reporting week of interest. For example, if entering up to date vaccination data for the week of January 15 – 21, 2024, please use the up to date definition corresponding to Quarter 1 2024 (January 1, 2024 – March 31, 2024). For more information regarding the up to date definitions, please refer to CDC NHSN COVID-19 Vaccination Modules: Understanding Key Terms and Up To Date Vaccination.

We suggest checking the reported number of healthcare personnel (Question #1) and the reported number of healthcare personnel who are up to date with COVID-19 vaccination as reported in Question #2.
- Number of individuals increased or decreased by greater than 30% compared to the prior week
 - Required Action
 - Please confirm that the number of individuals reported in Question #1 is correct.
