Dashboard	HAI/Dialysis Event Dashboard: A new dashboard was created to display Dialysis Event data submitted by dialysis facilities into NHSN. Data/statistics will be presented such as the count and rate of COVID cases, BSI rate, days since last infection, BSI SIR & CAD, and percentage of patients with CVC, all in graph and/or table form with adjustable timeframes. This is available for both Facility and Group users.	
Enrollment	A new facility type, AMB-HEMO-NTDS - Non Traditional Dialysis Setting , has been added to Enrollment for the Dialysis component. This new facility type allows NHSN to track patients being dialyzed in long term care settings by home health agencies.
