This letter is sent in support of the most recent NIOSH-proposed ruling on respiratory protective devices that relates to changes in the current procedures for testing and certifying air purifying respirators used for TB control. We at Appalachian Regional Healthcare, a not-for-profit healthcare system serving the rural areas of Kentucky, West Virginia, and Virginia, have been duly concerned over the rising incidence of tuberculosis, and, subsequently, utilization of the appropriate protective personal equipment to safequard our staff and patients.

ARH strives to comply with CDC, OSHA, and NIOSH criteria/guidelines, but it has been difficult to determine, of late, what type of respiratory protective device will meet all the regulations. Consequently, we strongly advocate new testing and certification procedures so that a broader range of more practical and economic respirators will be made available. We, in fact, believe this endeavor is urgent.
