To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to voice my support for the reclassification of respirators. As the Infection Control Coordinator for a 196 bed facility, I have documented that PPD convertions at our hospital were lowered with early identification and isolation of suspect and/or proven TB patients. This was accomplished while using a submicron mask for AFB isolation. Our PPD conversion rate was 0 % for 1993 and remains so through second quarter 1994. We had 4 cases of MTB in 1993 and 1 case so far this year. With the current OSHA recommendations, we are required to change from a submicron mask that is apparently working to a HEPA-filtered respirator. Please consider the above as you determine the future of respiratory protection in healthcare.
