- 4. Drawing show the "rule of nine" burns of victim/location (if cause of death)
- 5. Dept. training as it relates to incident (vent.class (3hrs), hose line ops.(3)hrs) in the last year.
- 6. Experience of IC
- 7. Org./flow chart of the incident
