## Comments

For the safety of all emergency personnel NIOSH need to eliminate the 1984 prohibition on buddy breathing. The changes in technology have increased the efficiency and safety of using a buddy breathing device. Exposure to IDLH is eliminated and allows for rescue options that other systems do not offer. NIOSH approval of a buddy breathing system will initiate NFPA testing procedures, training and operational use standards.

For Rapid Intervention and for the safety of our personnel, there is no exception to having a EBBS included with all breathing apparatus.
