Dear Sirs/Ma'am

I would like to suggest that the Zadroga Bill include ptsd and depression in the VCF portion of the bill. Please consider the following when implementing it's final policies.

1. The WTC Monitoring program acknowledges , treats and refers individuals based entirely upon a mental health injury. The Zadroga Bill identifies mental injuries as a causality of the attacks of September 11th.
2. The NYS WTC Presumption Bill identifies PTSD and Depression as a compensative injury directly related to the attacks at the WTC.
3. The SSA makes no distinction in regard to mental and physical injury

I would like that NIOSH Committee on the Zadroga Bill institute a rule that does not treats those with mental injury any different than those with physical injury. I think that such consideration is necessary in the interest of a fair and equal treatment for all that suffer as a result of the tragedies of September 11th.
