I was diagnosed with and underwent two operations in remove tumors from within my
I underwent Chemo-treatments and continue to have follow-up examinations. I know also that other employees, from both have had similar problems. Many are no longer with us.

To aid in your investigation you may want to check the health records of the many employees who worked in both . There were many, many, exposed and will most likely show the record of associated problems.
