I believe the requirement to maintain the breathing gas below 30% Oxygen is not realistic. It thirty years of my experience we have had no incidents with the OBA used by the navy for fire fighting. No incidents in the mining industry with 100% oxygen.

As a compromise position, please consider a NITROX mixture of 50 to 60%.

Removing this requirement will significantly reduce the cost of appliances to the end user.
