The Center for Public Safety Excellence (CPSE) Board of Directors voted unanimously during our recent meeting to formalize CPSE's support for the National Firefighter Registry (NFR) for Cancer.

CPSE's vision addresses collaboratively working to improve health, wellness, and safety outcomes. The mission of the NFR is to generate detailed knowledge about cancer in the fire service through a voluntary registry that reflects our nation's diverse firefighters.
