




Status & Location of NIOSH Referrals

 - 39,343 with Dose Reconstruction
 - 6,203 withdrawn from NIOSH with no Dose Reconstruction
- 2,000 Cases Currently at NIOSH




Compensation Part B Cancer Cases w/ Final Decision to Accept

- Accepted Dose Reconstruction Cases 10,095
 \$1.5 Billion in Compensation
- Accepted SEC Cases 24,887
 - → \$3.71 Billion in Compensation
- Cases Accepted Based on SEC Status <u>and</u> POC ≥ 50% 934
 - > \$140.1 Million in Compensation
- Totals: All Accepted SEC, Dose Reconstruction Cases, and Combined – 35,916
 - > \$5.3 Billion in Compensation


