Updates

- Joint Outreach Task Group met in Ames, Iowa about Special Exposure Cohort class addition
- Authorized representative workshop set for May in Kennewick, WA
- Budget



Cases

- 48,835 cases to NIOSH from Department of Labor (DOL)
 - 1,238 at NIOSH for dose reconstruction (DR)
 - 827 administratively closed
- 46,770 returned to DOL

Note: All data as of March 31, 2018



Cases cont.

- -41,763 submitted with DR to DOL
 - 1,538 pulled from DR by DOL
 - 3,469 pulled for SEC



Cases cont.

- 1,238 active cases at NIOSH for DR
 - 341 in DR process
 - 254 initial draft DR reports with claimants
 - 643 cases in DR development



PC Summary

- -41,763 DRs sent back for final adjudication
 - **11,636** PC ≥50%
 - **30,127** PC < 50%



DOE records Requests

- —225 outstanding
- 6 more than 60 days



Summary of first 20,000 DRs ∞nt.

- —19,568 daims at DOL
 - 769 pulled for DOL issues
 - 2,062 pulled for SEC
- —16,737 submitted with DR



Summary of first 20,000 DRs ∞nt.

- -399 daims at NIOSH
- 357 administratively closed
 - 14 with claimants (0 initial, 14 DOL returns)
 - 28 DRs in process (1 initial, 27 DOL returns)
- 33 claim numbers deleted
