Part B Cancer Cases w/ Final Decision to Accept

- **Accepted Dose Reconstruction Cases - 10,514**
 - › **\$1.56 Billion in Compensation**
- **Accepted SEC Cases - 26,065**
 - › **\$3.9 Billion in Compensation**
- **Cases Accepted Based on SEC Status and POC \geq 50% - 1,021**
 - › **\$153.2 Million in Compensation**
- **Totals: All Accepted SEC, Dose Reconstruction Cases, and Combined - 37,600**
 - › **\$5.60 Billion in Compensation**


Status & Location of NIOSH Referrals

- **49,777 Cases Referred to NIOSH for Dose Reconstruction**
- **47,672 Cases Returned to DOL from NIOSH**
 - 41,342 with Dose Reconstruction
 - 6,330 withdrawn from NIOSH with no Dose Reconstruction
- **1,805 Cases Currently at NIOSH**


Part B Cases w/ Dose Reconstruction and Final Decision




