Part B Cancer Cases w/ Final Decision to Accept

- **Accepted Dose Reconstruction Cases - 10,628**
 - › **\$1.6 Billion in Compensation**
- **Accepted SEC Cases - 26,494**
 - › **\$4 Billion in Compensation**
- **Cases Accepted Based on SEC Status and POC \geq 50% - 1,038**
 - › **\$156 Million in Compensation**
- **Totals: All Accepted SEC, Dose Reconstruction Cases, and Combined - 38,160**
 - › **\$5.7 Billion in Compensation**


Status & Location of NIOSH Referrals

- **50,096 Cases Referred to NIOSH for Dose Reconstruction**
- **48,398 Cases Returned to DOL from NIOSH**
 - 42,013 with Dose Reconstruction
 - 6,385 withdrawn from NIOSH with no Dose Reconstruction
- **1,698 Cases Currently at NIOSH**




