NIOSH Related (SEC & DR) Cases

\$1.7 Billion Paid Dose Reconstruction Cases

16,157 Payees

\$188 Million approved SEC and POC 50% or greater cases*

1,444 Payees

*Refers to all cases accepted based on SEC status and POC 50% or greater. At least one specified cancer was approved based on SEC employment and at least one other cancer was approved based on the DR process resulting in a POC of 50% or greater.

NIOSH Referral Case Status

- 57,270 Cases Referred to NIOSH for Dose Reconstruction

- 55,643 Cases Returned to DOL from NIOSH
 - 48,778 at DOL with Dose Reconstruction
 - 6,865 withdrawn from NIOSH with no Dose Reconstruction

- 1,627 Cases Currently at NIOSH
 - 1,137 Initial/Original Referral to NIOSH
 - 430 Reworks or Returns to NIOSH



Part B Cases with Dose Reconstruction and Final Decision




