When breast, cervical or colon cancers are found at an early stage, the five-year survival rate is 90% or more. Routine screening can prevent about 15 to 30 percent of deaths from breast cancer among women over age 40. Nearly all deaths from cervical cancer can be prevented by regular Pap tests. Deaths from colon cancer can be reduced by at least 33% with regular screening.
