Too many people in still suffer from tuberculosis (TB).



TB cases reported in 2023

9,633 cases of TB were reported in the U.S. in 2023

The TB case rate is:

per 100,000 people

The national average is 2.9 per 100,000 people

## TB IS PREVENTABLE & CURABLE.



TB is spread through the air from one person to another.

Symptoms of TB disease include:

- Cough lasting longer than 3 weeks
- Chest pain
- Night sweats
- Weight loss
- Weakness
- Chills
- Fever

A typical person with TB disease in the United States requires:


- X-rays

To eliminate TB, we must prioritize groups at increased risk for TB:



People at increased risk for TB infection should get tested.



Treating latent TB infection prevents TB disease.
